CODE OF CONDUCT FOR YOUNG PEOPLE

This code of conduct is based on the following principles;

- Respect for Club members
- Respect for Club property

Behaviour

No swearing or bad language.

No horseplay which may cause harm to others.

When asked by an adult member to refrain from doing something, please do so.

Conduct inside Clubhouse

Help to keep clubhouse tidy.

No throwing or kicking balls of any kind.

No gambling for money.

No card games when there are visiting clubs on site

Conduct within Club grounds.

No football during club matches.

Football may take place during internal matches, unless you are asked not to by those playing.

No football during Men's or Ladies' Nights.

No football on court.

If a ball goes into the neighbouring gardens, you are NOT to retrieve it by climbing through hedges/fencing, but must go round to the house & ask for it

No golf.
